


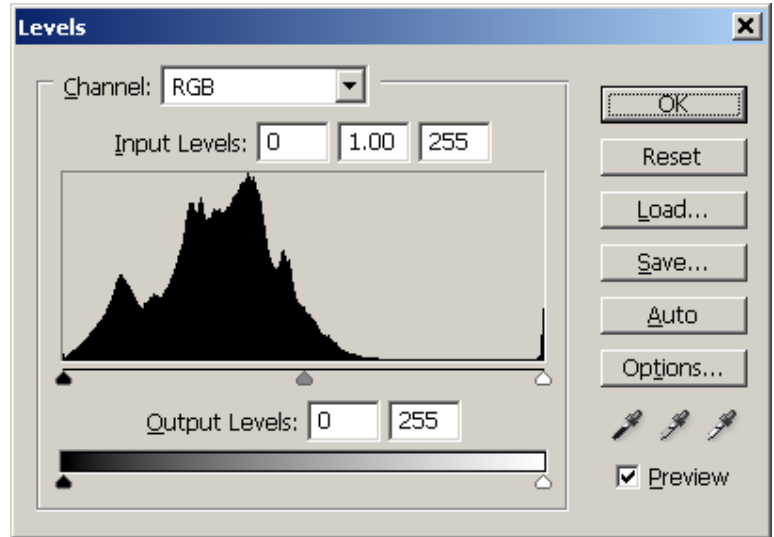
Open your image & choose LEVELS

Select the 'gray' eyedropper 

Now 'click' on an area of your image that should be neutral.

Photoshop will adjust the Red, Green & Blue channels so this area is now neutral.

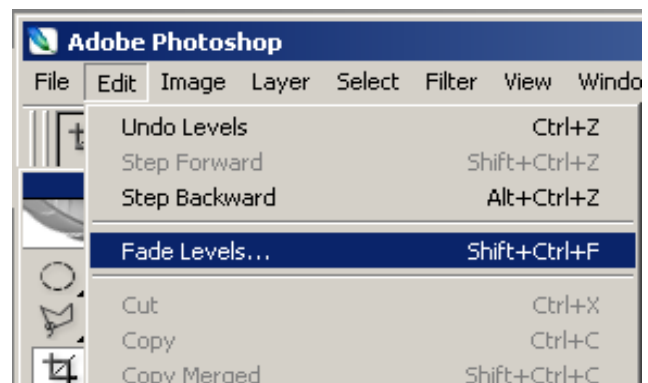
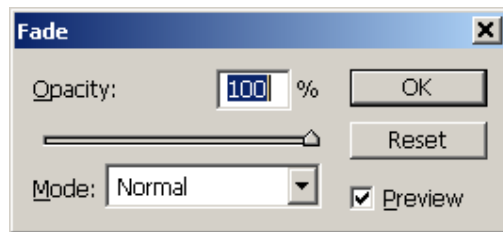
Note – by checking/un-checking the PREVIEW 'checkbox' you can see the effect of your selection.



Only by selecting 'OK' will you action this change (even then you can undo this by pressing {Ctrl and Z})

After either of these procedures, if you think the effect is 'too much' you can FADE the results by selecting 'fade' from the 'edit' menu

This will display the 'fade' dialogue box & as-long as the 'preview' box is checked – the results of adjusting the percentage can be seen.



This command MUST be selected immediately....
